

21-015 QA PRODUCT RECALL – SELECT AEROSOL SUNSCREEN PRODUCTS BY JOHNSON & JOHNSON

Scope: WORLDWIDE RETAIL FACILITIES AND DCs

Description: Johnson & Johnson has issued a voluntary recall for select NEUTROGENA® and AVEENO® aerosol sunscreen product lines due to internal testing that revealed low levels of benzene.

Hazard: Benzene is classified as a human carcinogen, a substance that could potentially cause cancer depending on the level and extent of exposure. Daily exposure to benzene in these aerosol sunscreen products at the levels detected in the internal testing would not be expected to cause adverse health consequences; however, out of an abundance of caution, the company is recalling all lots of these specific aerosol sunscreen products.

Remedy: While the use of these products would not be expected to cause adverse health consequences, we are asking consumers to stop using these products and appropriately discard them. To discard products, consumers should follow their local disposal procedures. Consumers can contact their local waste management services for more information.

Incidents/Injuries: To date, no illnesses or consumer complaints have been reported in connection with this recall.
