

Del Monte Recalls Select Ready To Eat Apple Peanut Butter Products Due Potential Salmonella Contamination

Recall Date: 25 May 2022

Description: The J. M. Smucker Co. voluntary recall of select Jif® products has prompted Fresh Del Monte to voluntarily recall fresh-cut fruit and vegetable products containing ready-to-eat Jif® peanut butter dip due to potential *Salmonella* contamination. Hazard: *Salmonella* is an organism which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Healthy persons infected with *Salmonella* often experience fever, diarrhea (which may be bloody), nausea, vomiting and abdominal pain. In rare circumstances, infection with *Salmonella* can result in the organism getting into the bloodstream and producing more severe illnesses such as arterial infections (i.e., infected aneurysms), endocarditis and arthritis.
