Hazard: An unlocked handle can pinch consumers' fingers against the generator frame when the generator is moved posing finger amputation and crushing hazards.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled portable generators unless the locking pin has been inserted to secure the handle in place before and after moving the generator. Contact Generac for a free repair kit consisting of a set of spacers to move the handle away from the frame, eliminating the pinch point. Customers who had responded to the original recall will automatically be sent a new kit.

Incidents/Injuries: To date, a total of 37 reports of injuries, 24 resulting in finger amputations and 5 in finger crushing.
