


Clorox Recalls Select Pine-Sol Due To Potential Microbial Contamination

Recall Date: 25 October 2022

Description: The Clorox Company issued a voluntary product recall to the consumer level of select lot codes of Pine-Sol® products with date codes beginning with the prefix “A4” and followed by a five-digit number of 22249 or lower due to potential microbial contamination. Hazard: The recalled products may contain bacteria, including *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, an environmental organism found widely in soil and water. People with weakened immune systems or external medical devices who are exposed to *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* face a risk of serious infection that may require medical treatment. The bacteria can enter the body if inhaled, through the eyes, or through a break in the skin. People with healthy immune systems are usually not affected by the bacteria.
