

*The SKU and Date Code are on the silver data plate on the back of grill. The date code is a 4-digit code (YYMM) located within the Flatrock's serial number (see the example below). Grills with a red sticker on the data plate have already been inspected and repaired and are not subject to this recall.



If your Flatrock matches the SKU and Date Codes above and does not have a red sticker, follow the instructions in the remedy section below.

Hazard: The incorrect burner control knobs can result in the grill fuel supply being unintentionally left in an open position, posing a fire hazard.

Remedy: Immediately stop using your Flatrock grill and <u>click here</u> to follow the manufacturer's instructions to inspect the burner control knobs and request a free repair kit.

Incidents/Injuries: The firm has received 57 reports of flame adjustment knobs being incorrectly labeled. No fires or injuries have been reported.
