



Stanley Black & Decker Recalls DeWALT Battery Walk-Behind Mowers Due To Laceration Hazard

Recall Date: 15 Aug 2024

Description: DeWALT is recalling select DeWALT Battery Walk-Behind Mowers due to a Laceration hazard. For more details, please visit the [CPSC website](#).

*The model number is on the rear door of the mower. The affected mowers have a date code between 2023 32-58 and 2024 13-58, which is laser-printed in yellow above the left rear wheel. Mowers made after March 2024 (2024 14-58) are not affected.

Hazard: If water gets into the mower's handle support while the battery is installed, the mower can fail to shut off when the bail handle is released or start without a key, posing a laceration hazard to the user.

Remedy: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled mowers if the mower has gotten wet and contact DeWALT to receive a free repair at an authorized service center nearby.

Incidents/Injuries: To date, there have been 10 reports of mowers failing to shut off when the bail handle is released and one report of a mower starting without a key inserted. The incident involving the mower starting without a key resulted in a finger laceration, which did not require medical attention.
